DIRECTIONS

FROM NEW HAVEN

Take 91N to Exit 15 (Yalesville/Durham), Turn right off of the exit onto CT-68, in .9 miles turn left to stay on CT-68, follow to the end (approximately 4.25 miles), Turn left onto Main St/CT-17 and follow for 5 miles, Turn right onto Lake St (between KFC & Illiano's restaurant), the building is 1 block up on the right. It's a brick building with a flag in the front. The entrance is on the flagpole side. Parking is on either side of the building or on the street.

FROM HARTFORD

Take I-91 South to Exit 22S (Route 9 South toward Middletown/Old Saybrook). Stay on Route 9 South for approximately 6.3 miles. Take exit 13 (CT-17 toward New Haven). Turn left onto CT-17/South Main Street. In approximately 1/2 a mile, turn left onto Lake St (between KFC & Illiano's restaurant), the building is 1 block up on the right. It's a brick building with a flag in the front. The entrance is on the flagpole side. Parking is on either side of the building or on the street.

FROM ROUTE 9 SOUTH

Take exit 13 (CT-17 toward New Haven) and follow directions above.

FROM ROUTE 9 NORTH

Take exit 11 (Randolph Rd/CT-155), Turn left onto Randolph Rd and follow for 1.6 miles, turn slight left to stay on Randolph Rd. In .5 miles, turn right onto South Main St/CT-17. In 1 miles, turn right onto Lake Street (between Illiano's restaurant and KFC). The building is 1 block up on the right.
